

Snow Removal Position

Clearing snow and ice from properties (roads, sidewalks, driveways, parking lots) using equipment like plows, blowers, and shovels, applying de-icers, and working outdoors in harsh winter conditions, seasonally and on-call, with responsibilities including site safety, equipment maintenance, and following client protocols to ensure clear, accessible, and safe properties.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Operation:** Operate heavy equipment (plows, loaders, blowers, salt spreaders) and hand tools (shovels) to clear snow and ice.
- **Site Maintenance:** Apply salt and other de-icing agents
- **Safety & Compliance:** Maintain safe job sites, follow traffic laws, wear appropriate gear, and work around active traffic.
- **Equipment Care:** Perform basic maintenance on tools and vehicles, keep them clean.
- **Reporting:** Maintain logs of work performed, materials used, and any issues encountered.

TYPICAL REQUIREMENTS

- **Physical Stamina:** Ability to work outdoors in cold, snowy, icy conditions, lifting up to 50+ lbs.
- **Availability:** Must be available for irregular hours, including nights, weekends, and holidays during storms.
- **Skills:** Equipment operation, understanding safety protocols, teamwork, communication, and sometimes a valid driver's license/CDL.
